1. The application cover page (see page 1)
2. The letter of commitment, signed (typed signature) by your faculty research advisor and department head (see page 2)
3. A copy of your unofficial transcript
4. A one page research statement that addresses the following items (use 10 point font and 1" margins):
 - a) *Significance of Research*
Briefly explain the purpose of the proposed research and how it fits into other USU research programs. What will be the impact of the research?
 - b) *Objectives*
Provide a detailed list of what you hope to accomplish.
 - c) *Plan to Meet Objectives*
Explain how you will achieve each objective. Specify any equipment needed and your access to the equipment.
 - d) *Research Timeline*. Your timeline for completing your objectives can include Summer 2017, Fall 2017, and Spring 2018. Research must be complete by the end of the Spring 2018 semester.
5. One page of photos, graphs, or drawings (if applicable) to support your text.
